I will provide some of my information that comes from knowing specific people and their psychopathological conditions. The disease affected younger people who were drugged before the outbreak of the disease. Other common features include hallucinations (including entities), non-recognition of their illness, sexual fantasies and activities with diminished restraint, egocentricity, thoughts of death and suicide, actual suicide, fear, anxiety, panic, depression.

We need to understand that such stressful mental states inevitably cause a multitude of psychosomatic physical consequences. All of these signs and symptoms could be categorized into a terrifying collection of the following possible diagnoses: schizophrenia, panic disorder, neurocirculatory dystonia, neurovegetative asthenia syndrome. The person claimed to have no diagnosis and also denied possible self-medication by Grabovoy's methods.

I also know of another example of a younger woman who had similar signs and symptoms, but the person took an initiative and successfully approached the study and use of Grabovo's healing technologies. When I met her again a few years later, she was completely healed and tidy. 3. Broader and deeper aspects of schizophrenia

Psychology and mentality are inherently slippery and challenging terrain. However, occult, esoteric and symptomatic causes of mental disorders are not yet addressed in medical science. This is why some films may be helpful in addressing such un-established topics.

Stigmata covers the deepest questions and broader context regarding our Christian dogma, which pushes our sexuality deep into the subconscious. It is the same with our duplicity, reproach and all other deviations & the consequent social - individual psychosocial pathologies. The film also includes a plastic seeing of the possible influence of entities on humans, as well as the process of exorcism. The movie story forces us to reflect on issues of ethics, morality, sexuality and insanity.

Both proposed films remind us of the possible unconfirmed backgrounds of pathological psychomental states that are not recognized in medicine. Here, we cannot deal with the consequences of entities and black magic, and the consequent states of abuse of hallucinatory and intoxicating agents. The simple notion of folk is the notion of obsession with the evil spirit. And we do not know how to identify and deal with symptomatic conditions. Nevertheless, it is good to be aware of these issues because of the right direction in finding solutions.

Basically, we are interested in who could even be involved in solving the problems identified here in the background of schizophrenia. They cover the whole field in their own ways, for example: magic, esotericism, exorcism, shamanism, theosophy. And we can find many other systems such as. Ayurveda, Kabbalah, etc.

In practice, exorcists and shamans do not deal with the mental illness of schizophrenia, and psychiatry does not deal with the potential consequences of black magic, entities, and symptomatic conditions. Therefore, it would be inconsistent to attribute all phantom sounds, illusions, or hallucinations to mental illness. What are the possible alternative aspects?

4. Conclusion

There is a risk of unwanted opening of the microcosmic portal to lower intangible dimensions, which are inhabited by various lower entities and filled with impure energies. This can happen temporarily or permanently due to drug and alcohol abuse. Consequent 'illusions' and 'eavesdropping' are commonly called 'hallucinations'. And it makes no sense to talk about the (in)reality of these 'hallucinations'. Everyone can draw his own conclusion about this, which, of course, depends on previous experiences, the structuring of his consciousness and the development of perception.

The same thinking can be applied to 'hallucinations' in schizophrenia. Orto medicine has no instruments, nor does it have any senses and criteria that can differentiate between 'pathological' and 'real' 'hallucinations'. At the same time, we can conclude that the dreams and the subconscious are also on the other side of a dimensional portal, which is closed in the awake consciousness. Dreams are not a disease, are they?

This raises the important question of whether a person's 'willingness' can be a discriminatory factor between the real experience of other dimensions and the 'pathological hallucinations' of schizophrenia. Part of the text leads the reader to think that these are the same contents that are perceived and understood once as a disease and another as clairvoyance. This, in turn, depends on the difference in the structuring of consciousness and in the development of perception. 'The beautiful mind' speaks volumes for itself.

For now, I take the view that the uncontrolled opening of a dimensional portal in a spiritually and psychologically unprepared person means 'illness' (eg schizophrenia). This should be treated by closing the door - healing of the 'membrane' between the material and immaterial worlds (dimensions).

And we do this with a corresponding Grabovoi's number set for schizophrenia. There is also an urgent need to address the associated and accompanying problems. One of the potentially very likely ones is panic disorder.
